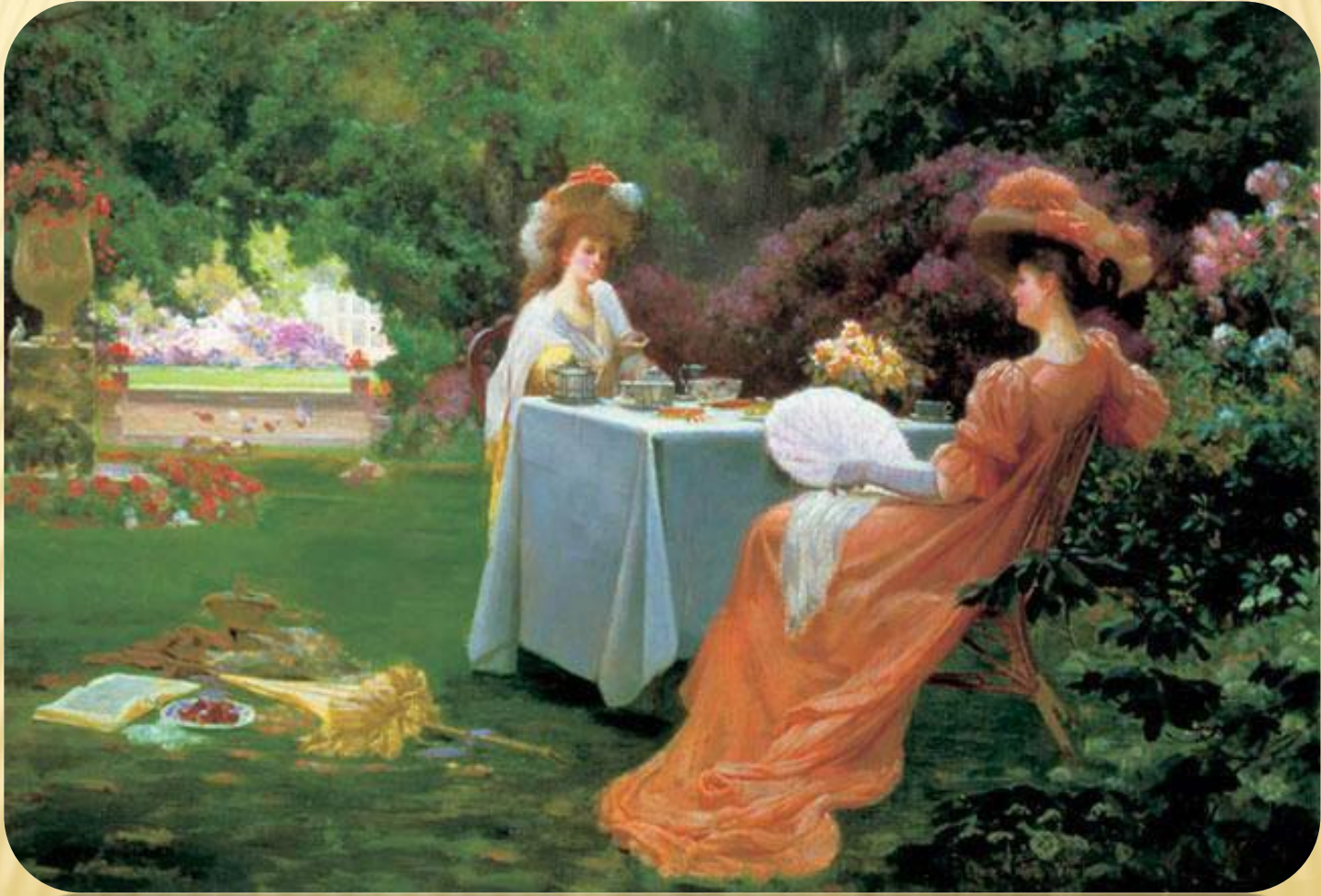

Carrot Pie Recipe

- 3 cups grated **carrots**
- 4 **eggs**
- 1 1/4 cups **oil**
- 2 cups **sugar**
- 2 cups **flour**
- 2 teaspoons **baking soda**
- 1/2 teaspoon **salt**
- 2 teaspoons **cinnamon**

Scones Recipe

- ✘ 350g flour
- ✘ ¼ teaspoon salt
- ✘ 1 teaspoon baking powder
- ✘ 85g butter, cut into cubes
- ✘ 3 tablespoon sugar
- ✘ 175ml milk
- ✘ 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ✘ lemon juice
- ✘ beaten egg
